Behavioral health and emotional well-being services is offered at your congregation through: Onsite behavioral health programs Examples stress management work/life balance or depression screenings counseling mental health first aid art therapy training on how to recognize the signs and symptoms of substance training abuse (including prescription drug abuse) substance abuse prevention suicide prevention activities training (such as QPR (question persuade and refer and HELP (healthy education for life program) for teens, etc. Hosting or advertising recovery support groups (e.g. Celebrate Recovery, Al-Anon family groups, alcoholic anonymous, gamblers anonymous, etc.) Promotion of the Suicide Prevention Lifeline (1-800-273-TALK (8255)). E.g. signs, posters, flyers, website, social media, etc. Promotion of the Problem Gambling Hotline (1-800-522-4700) E.g. signs, posters, flyers, website, social media, etc. Promotion of the Oklahoma Domestic Violence Abuse and Sexual Assault Safeline (1-800-522-SAFE (7233)) E.g. signs, posters, flyers, website, social media, etc.
