INSTRUCTIONS FOR AFFIDAVIT

WHAT IS IT?

The 'Mechanical Affidavit' is used to waive the bond and insurance requirements for a mechanical contractor. A DBA (Doing Business As) license is then issued. The license is only valid for the property listed on the affidavit. The contractor who holds the DBA license is liable for all mechanical work performed during the time that he holds the license.

WHO CAN USE IT?

Hospitals, schools and governmental agencies can use the 'Mechanical Affidavit'. Also, any contractor who works for a company that <u>owns</u> the property that he works on is eligible to use the affidavit. A management company <u>cannot</u> have a mechanical contractor on a DBA license.

HOW DO I ACTIVATE MY LICENSE?

The company you work for (Entity) must fill out the top part of the affidavit. The contractor needs to complete the lower part. Both the company section and the contractor section must be notarized. Attach a copy of proof of commercial general liability insurance for the company. We also require the contractor's <u>actual pocket license</u> be returned to us. We will not issue a DBA license without this.

By signing the affidavit, the contractor is taking responsibility for all work performed on the property. If either party terminates employment, the contractor is responsible for notifying us in writing that he is no longer the DBA for the company. If we do not receive notice, the Contractor can still be held liable for work performed.
