FAMILY & CHILD HEALTH

Children First:

A voluntary family support program offering home-based nursing services to mothers expecting their first child. Services by appointment only.

Dental Health:

No direct dental care is provided at the health department. Fluoride varnish is provided to those 18 years and younger. This dental treatment can help prevent tooth decay, slow it down, or stop it from getting worse.

Family Planning:

Birth control options, health education for adults, pregnancy testing, fertility counseling. Family planning helps prevent unplanned pregnancies. These services are available to both women and men.

Screening and Special Services:

Newborn screening, newborn hearing screening, lead screening and follow-up services for eligible infants, children and their families.

Sooner Start - Early Intervention:

Oklahoma's Early Intervention program designed to meet the needs of infants and toddlers up to age 3 with disabilities and/or developmental delays. For more information call (580) 585-6610.

WIC:

Provides access to nutritious foods to supplement the diets of women, infants and children. WIC offers information about healthy eating and promotes active lifestyles.



DISEASE TREATMENT & PREVENTION

Communicable Diseases:

Report a disease-related issue locally by calling the county health department. After hours, call (405) 426-8710 to speak with an Acute Disease Service epidemiologist.

Sexual Health Services:

Screening, diagnosing, educating, treating, individual case management, and referral services for those at increased risk for sexually transmitted infections. Condoms are available for health department clients.

HIV/STD/STI/Syphilis:

Sexual health screenings, diagnosis, education, treatment & referrals. Testing is always confidential.

Immunizations/Vaccines:

Immunizations for children as well as select immunizations for adults.
*May require a minimum fee.

Diphtheria, Whooping Cough, Tetanus, Polio, Hepatitis A & B, Pneumococcal, Flu, Chickenpox, Meningococcal, HiB, Measles, Mumps, Rubella, Human Papillomavirus, Shingles, Rotavirus, and COVID-19.

Tuberculosis:

Identify and treat tuberculosis patients and insure appropriate measures are taken to prevent the occurrence and transmission of tuberculosis.

Inspections and Licensing:

- Food establishments (permanent, temporary and mobile)
- Hotels, motels, bed and breakfasts
- Public swimming pools and spas

Technical Services:

- Food handlers classes and exams
