PRIMARY SERVICES

- **Children First** (home-based nursing services for first-time mothers)
- **Consumer Protection** (business/institutional inspections and licensing)
- **Communicable Disease Surveillance** (outbreak prevention for tuberculosis, food & waterborne illness, childhood diseases)
- **Child Guidance** (behavioral health, speech language pathology, child development)
- **Family Planning** (birth control options, health education for adults, pregnancy testing, fertility counseling)
- **Health Education** (free community presentations, health publications, CPR training)
- **Hearing/Speech/Language Screenings**
- **HIV/STD/STI** (sexual health screenings, diagnosis, education, treatment & referrals)
- **Immunizations** (vaccines for children & adults)
- **Medicaid Eligibility Checks**
- **Physicals** (annual well-check exams & sports physicals for children and adults)
- **Rash & Head Checks** (head lice control)
- **School Health** (consultation for physical & mental health in school environments)
- **SoonerStart** (early intervention program providing screenings, assessments, specialized services & therapy for infants and toddlers up to age 3)
- **Tobacco Cessation** (guidance & resources to quit smoking)
- **WIC** (nutritious foods & information on healthy eating)
- **Car Seats** (car seat installation, free car seat, car seat education)

Cost of Services

Pottawatomie County Health Department provides many health services at little to no cost. Insurance is not required to be seen, but if you have insurance, please bring your information with you. Please contact us with questions about specific services.



A variety of immunizations are available for infants, children and adults; most at no cost. We provide immunizations required for school attendance and childcare centers in Oklahoma, as well as immunization training and consultation for providers

Immunizations

OKLAHOMA WOMEN, INFANTS & CHILDREN PROGRAM (WIC)

Nutrition education and supplemental food program for low-income pregnant, breastfeeding and postpartum women, infants and children up to age five.

No-cost benefits include:

- Private consultations with dietitians
- Online nutrition education and fitness group classes.
- Breastfeeding peer counselors
- Variety of nutritious foods

Eligibility based on nutritional risk and income. If you are enrolled in SoonerCare or receiving Medicaid, SNAP or TANF, you are automatically eligible for WIC benefits.

FAMILY PLANNING

Promotes family involvement and provides education and outreach activities. All services are voluntary and confidential. Family planning services are offered on a sliding scale, based on income. Services will not be denied due to inability to pay.

STI/STD SERVICES

In order to eliminate and prevent the transmission of sexually transmitted diseases, we provide free confidential testing, evaluation, health education, and treatment for the following STDs:


- Gonorrhea
- Chlamydia
- Syphilis
- HIV
