#### Vital Records

Issued 477,000 birth and death records through mail and internet orders.



#### **Community Development**

Engaged the public with over 70,000 phone calls to support COVID-19 testing and vaccination.



#### **Women, Infants, & Children** Oklahoma's WIC program served almost 100,000 clients through health department and Indian Tribal programs.



**Emergency Preparedness & Response Service** Deployed 42 ventilators to hospitals across Oklahoma for COVID-19 support.

Helped over 250,000 people through our County Health Departments and delivered care through Mobile Wellness Units to rural Oklahomans across the state.

#### **Screening & Special Services**

Enhanced requirements for lead detection to protect Oklahoma's children.



#### Nursing Services

Administered over 6.5 million COVID-19 vaccine doses to Oklahomans.



#### **Injury Prevention**

Trained more than 70 new child passenger safety technicians to distribute and educate Oklahomans about car/booster seats.



**Chronic Disease & Prevention** Increased the percentage of Oklahomans protected from secondhand smoke by 3.6%.
