**Discussion and follow up on previous recommendations:** There were no updates regarding previous recommendations.

Key insights from the MMRIA conference: Barbara O'Brien spoke to the group regarding the MMRIA conference in Atlanta that she recently attended. She stated that all 50 states were represented and were introduced to the new form that needs to be completed for each case. She also spoke about the importance of conducting key informant interviews to gather additional information that may not be available in the Dr. notes and records. Nikki stated that with the staff shortage they are currently facing, unfortunately there isn't the manpower available to conduct these interviews. She did however mention that the Maternal and Child Health Service area is in the process of applying for the ERASE grant and if awarded, would like to hire some additional help to handle some of these interviews.

She also spoke about the importance of having a diverse committee that represents multiple areas of the population and professions.

Barbara also stated that there is a group of tribal across the states that are working on starting their own Maternal Mortality and Morbidity Committee for indigenous members who have died during pregnancy or postpartum period. Nick mentioned that the Tribal Public Health Conference was held the day prior to this meeting where they discussed four different options the tribes could have regarding their MMRC. First would be that a tribe could have their own MMRC, an area wide MMRC, a possibility of a sub-committee of the State MMRC, and a national committee.

**Discussion regarding legislative bills-** Dr. Hawkins updated the committee on a Legislative bill they have been watching. She stated that HB 2152 is a bill that when written would have required all maternal deaths be referred to the State Medical Examiners for autopsy. This bill will reduce the size of the MMRC from 24 to 11 committee members. This bill has passed both houses of the legislature and is now being reviewed by the House for determination of which entities will be eliminated.

**Moment of silence:** Dr. Smith asked the members to observe a moment of silence in remembrance of the women who lost their lives and the families they left behind.

**Enter into Executive Session:** Lori Essary made a motion to enter into Executive Session with Regina Kizer seconding. Members voted accordingly.
