9 There was no physical meeting location with Board members participating remotely using the Microsoft
10 Teams teleconferencing platform reflected on the attached attendance sheet.

- 12 III. Introductions and Announcements.....Jamie McAlister, Chair
13 Jennifer Woodrow introduced Rebecca Novak as the new Region 1 representative taking her place.

- 15 IV. Approval of Minutes – November 13, 2020.....Jamie McAlister, Chair
16 A motion to approve the minutes as written was made by Watonga EMS and seconded by Life EMS. There
17 was no discussion and the motion passed 12-0.
- 18
- 19 V. Reports/Updates
- 20 A. Emergency Systems.....Rebecca Novak
21 Staff has completed the move to the new Oklahoma Commons Building with most staff still
22 teleworking from home. There are two open positions at the Oklahoma State Department of Health
23 (OSDH). Daniel Whipple moved to a new position outside of the Health Department. His position is
24 posted for a Trauma Systems Coordinator along with a Statistical Research Specialist position for
25 OKEMESIS. We are working on adding current trauma plans to EMResource and updating the OSDH
26 webpage to ensure all information is available. Program area contact information and upcoming
27 training dates were presented by Rebecca Novak with all information available on the OSDH website.

31 2021 at 1:00 p.m. It is not known at this time if it will be in person or online.
- 32 B. Quality Improvement (QI) Committee.....Valerie Schultz
33 The QI Committee met on March 23, 2021 via Microsoft teams. There were 12 cases discussed and 18
34 letters to be sent out. Some letters will require a response and some are good job letters. One case
35 was closed by the committee. The QI Committee is getting caught up on cases to review.
- 36 C. Regional Planning Committee (RPC).....Jamie McAlister, Chair
37 The RPC met this morning prior to the Regional Trauma Advisory Board (RTAB). One of the biggest
38 goals was to look at the 2021 trauma system goals and discussion took place on how to reduce
39 percentages across the board due to a patient initially going to an inappropriate Level III or Level IV
40 facility. The first 2021 trauma system goal is to decrease the number of Priority 1 patients delivered
41 to a Level III or Level IV Trauma Center by three percent per year. If an additional five to six Priority 1
42 patients per year are delivered to a Level I or Level II Trauma Center, this will meet the three percent
43 decrease. The second trauma system goal is to decrease the length of stay at a Level III or Level IV
44 Trauma Center for a Priority 1 trauma patient with an injury severity score (ISS) of greater than 16 by
45 three percent. This goal will be met if a Priority 1 patient is transferred to a Level I or Level II Trauma
46 Center six minutes faster.

- 48 D. Regional Medical Response System.....Paulette Marshall
- 49 The next meeting for the Regional Medical Planning Group (RMPG) is this day at 1:00 p.m. The link to
- 50 access the RMPG meeting is available from Ms. Marshall. The Oklahoma State Department of Health
- 51 is now distributing available Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) to the medical facilities through the
- 52 regional warehouses. This is different from before when the Medical Emergency Response Center
- 53 (MERC) was distributing PPE. There are warehouses in Enid and Woodward and distribution of
- 54 available PPE is based on a first come, first served basis. Ms. Marshall is currently working on
- 55 deliverables to finish out this period along with the work plan and budget for next period. In person
- 56 area meetings are planned to be held in June.
- 57 E. EMS for Children.....Delores Welch
- 58 There was no representative to give a report.
- 59 F. Preparing for Chemical Emergencies Ad Hoc Committee.....Paulette Marshall
- 60 Paulette Marshall stated there is nothing to report.
- 61 G. Trauma Plan & Bylaw Ad Hoc Committee.....Jamie McAlister, Chair
- 62 Jamie McAlister announced the committee is moving forward with recommendations that will be
- 63 discussed later in the meeting.
- 64 H. Stroke Regional Planning Ad Hoc Committee.....Erin Fast
- 65 Rebecca Novak received an email from Erin Fast stating that she is no longer able to Chair this
- 66 committee and is stepping down effective immediately.

- 68 VI. Business
- 69 A. Discussion, consideration, possible action and vote to approve amendments to the Region 1 Trauma
- 70 Plan pending review of Medical Emergency Response center (MERC) recommendations and the
- 71 approved Letter Schedule of Escalation and placement within the Region 1 Trauma
- 72 Plan.....Jamie McAlister, Chair
- 73 There were questions about the proposed Region 1 Trauma Plan amendments that MERC originally
- 74 recommended. The two recommendations were that the MERC should no longer have the authority
- 75 to deny or discontinue emergency department divert based on the need of the community as well as
- 76 the authority to place ambulance services on a rotating basis to avoid oversaturation. The question
- 77 was if the hospital goes on emergency divert and the MERC or the designee no longer handles the
- 78 diversions, who will take over responsibility. After discussion with the MERC representative, Paulette
- 79 Marshall, the proposed amendments will be eliminated, and the MERC will continue to have the
- 80 authority for the two recommendations listed above. Jennifer Woodrow discussed what would be
- 81 voted on today regarding the updates from the last meeting by eliminating Appendix A and moving
- 82 the EMS provider description to just one place. It also includes the addition of the quality
- 83 improvement language into the Letter Schedule of Escalation process and moving the Letter Schedule
- 84 of Escalation into Appendix D. The vote will also include not making any changes to the MERC for
- 85 either hospital or EMS. Jamie Lee reiterated the proposed amendments and reviewed the placement
- 86 of the amendments within the Region 1 Trauma Plan. A motion to approve the proposed amendment
- 87 changes was made by St. Mary's Regional Medical Center and seconded by AllianceHealth
- 88 Woodward. There was no discussion and the motion passed 12-0.

What is the National Pediatric Readiness Project?

The National Pediatric Readiness Project (NPRP) is a multi-phase quality improvement initiative to ensure that all U.S. emergency departments have the essential guidelines and resources in place to provide effective emergency care to children.



The project is supported by the American College of Emergency Physicians, the Emergency Nurses Association, the American Academy of Pediatrics, and the Federal Emergency Medical Services (EMS) for Children Program.



What is the 2021 NPRP Assessment?

A National Assessment of Emergency Departments (ED)s to:

- Determine progress in pediatric readiness
- Identify existing gaps
- Promote quality improvement (QI) efforts in EDs across the country
- Develop national collaboratives to address common and critical gaps
- Identify best practices





How does my ED participate?

Participating in the 2021 NPRP assessment is EASY!


ED Nurse Managers will receive several postal and email notifications with a link to the web-based assessment.

Since only one NPRP assessment per ED can be completed, we encourage you to collaborate with your ED leadership to participate in the NPRP assessment.



ED Nurse Managers who complete the NPRP assessment will immediately receive:

- An ED pediatric readiness score from 0 – 100
- The average pediatric readiness score of EDs of similar pediatric volume
- The average pediatric readiness score of all participating EDs to use as a benchmark
- An ED Gap Report to target efforts for improvement in pediatric readiness




Why is participation important?

The NPRP assessment helps ED personnel to be better prepared to provide quality care for all patients of all ages by evaluating the QI process of EDs over time.

- Hospitals with high ED readiness scores demonstrate a 4-fold lower rate of mortality for children with critical illness than those with lower readiness scores; thus, improving pediatric readiness improves outcomes for children and their families.

Hospital leadership, healthcare administrators, and ED personnel can demonstrate commitment to their communities by improving pediatric readiness. Encourage participation in the assessment to ensure that all EDs are pediatric ready!
