Approval of Minutes – May 18, 2021......Jason Likens, Interim Chair 24 A motion to approve the minutes as written was made by Elizabeth Lambert and seconded by Julia Day. There was 25 no discussion and the motion passed 3-0. 26 27 ٧. **Business** 28 A. Discussion, consideration, possible action, and approve new Chair for Regional Planning Committee (RPC) – 29 30 Mr. Likens appointed Elizabeth Lambert as the new RPC Chair. There was no discussion. No vote was needed. 31 Discussion, consideration, and possible vote to approve action pending review of the annual survey and Region 32 6 Trauma Plan......Jason Likens, Interim Chair 33 Mr. Likens stated the goal of conducting an annual survey gave EMS services guidance for time sensitive 34 conditions. At the time of the survey, it was noted that there was not a stroke plan implemented and services 35 were not sure what to do for these patients. Discussion took place discussing how time sensitive issues such as 36 stroke can be included in the regional trauma plan to help with consistency at hospitals. Mr. Likens suggested 37 combining business items B and C. Business items B include the annual survey and Region 6 trauma plan 38 remaining as currently written. 39 Discussion, consideration, possible action, and vote to approve amendments to the Region 6 Stroke Plan for 40 recommendation to the RTAB......Jason Likens, Interim Chair 41 Discussion took place on improving care, consistency at hospitals for EMS providers to know where to take a 42 stroke patient, holding EMS and hospitals accountable by updating the necessary websites, and stroke 43 initiatives. It was discussed that hospitals in Region 6 look at the stroke plan during the RTAB and acknowledge 44 if the information is still accurate. The regional liaisons appointed by the Oklahoma State Stroke System 45 Advisory Council (OSSSAC) are available for questions. A motion was made to combine business items B and C, 46 accepting the annual survey as current, accepting the Region 6 trauma plan as voted on previously by RTAB, 47 and implementing the current stroke plan as written by Elizabeth Lambert and seconded by Julia Day. There 48 was no further discussion and the motion passed 3-0. 49 Discussion, consideration, and possible vote to approve action for recommendation to the RTAB for regional 50 51 1.  - requirements. There was discussion on how to get Region 6 hospitals and EMS working together to accomplish the two new trauma goals in 2022 that were voted on at RTAB. Suggestions of how to accomplish these goals were made by Mr. Likens and Ms. Lambert which included but were not limited
