Minutes

- III. **Introductions and Announcements**.....Kenneth Nickels, Chair

- IV. **Approval of the October 19, 2021 minutes**.....Kenneth Nickels, Chair
A motion to approve the October 19, 2021 minutes was made by Russell Martin and seconded by Stacie Boyd. There was no discussion and the motion passed 5-0.

- VI. **Business**
 - A. Discussion, consideration, possible action and vote to approve the results of the Trauma Plan Workgroup.....Kenneth Nickels, Chair
Still working on the Trauma Plan updates. Mr. Martin suggested contacting the Medical Emergency Response Committee (MERC) to see if they already have Mass Causality Incident (MCI) plan in place. Mr. Call asked if the MCI should be in the trauma plan or kept separate. Mr. Henke shared the there is a region that is voting on putting the MCI in their trauma plan. Mr. McLemore suggested putting a MCI plan in the appendix. The committee will continue with the workgroup and report back at the next meeting. Stacie Boyd resigned from the RPC but will stay on the work group as a consultant.



- B. Discussion, consideration, possible action and vote to review the top reasons for improvement for hospitals and EMS agencies.....Kenneth Nickels, Chair
The committee discussed the top reasons for hospital and EMS agencies delays. They will finish the trauma plan edits then revisit this business item. No action taken.
- C. Discussion, consideration, possible action and vote to approve a plan to:
 - 1. Decrease the number of Priority 1 patients transported by ambulance services to a Level III or Level IV Trauma Center by 3% by the end of the calendar year 2022.
 - 2. Decrease the statewide average length of stay at Level III and Level IV Trauma Centers for patients having an ISS of ≥16 by 3% by the end of calendar year 2022.

The committee tabled this item until the trauma plan edits are finished. No action taken.

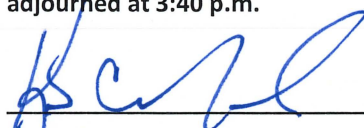
VII. New Business
