



- Burn injury in patients with preexisting medical disorders compromising healing and survival (cardiac disease, chronic respiratory illness, diabetes);
- Multisystem trauma with partial or full thickness burns as the predominant injury.

If the burn patient cannot be oxygenated or ventilated, transport the patient to the nearest appropriate emergency department for airway management.

Motion made to amend the vote to change the 20% body surface area at OU Health to 'up to 40%' at OU Health while including the corrected facility names in the burn plan to Integris Baptist Medical Center – Northwest Expressway, OU Health, and Oklahoma Children's Hospital at OU Health and approved.
