<p>Definitions</p>	<p><b>Healthcare settings</b> - refers to places where healthcare is delivered and includes, but is not limited to, acute care facilities, long term acute care facilities, inpatient rehabilitation facilities, nursing homes and assisted living facilities, home healthcare, vehicles where healthcare is delivered (e.g., mobile clinics), and outpatient facilities, such as dialysis centers, physician offices, and others. <p>Considerations for Risk Assessments - In every case, individual facilities need to consider "their" risk assessments. This concept should be applied when reviewing the following information</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Community Transmission Levels</li> <li>• Consider the individuals needs and use a person-centered approach</li> <li>• Adherence to Infection Prevention Control practices in healthcare setting, in transportation, and in the community</li> <li>• Upon identification of an individual with symptoms consistent with COVID-19, or when tests positive for COVID-19, take actions to prevent the transmission of COVID-19</li> </ul>
