Attachment 1, Explanation of Chapter 662 Changes

§310:662-1-2 defined “Non-physician practitioner” as a nurse practitioner, clinical nurse specialist, or physician assistant providing primary or specialty care to a home care patient.

§310:662-1-2 defined “Physician” to mean a medical doctor (MD), doctor of osteopathic medicine (DO), or doctor of podiatric medicine (DPM)

310:662-3-5(e) added the words “or non-physician practitioner” after the word “physician.”

310:662-3-5(e) (1) added the words, “or non-physician practitioner” after the word “physician.”

310:662-3-5(e) (3) replaced the word “or non-physician practitioner” two times with as the person responsible to sign and return agency orders timely.

310:662-3-5(e) (4) added the words “or non-physician practitioner” as the person a discharge summary would be provided to at patient discharge.

310:662-3-6(c) (2) added the words “or non-physician practitioner” from whom orders must be maintained for home infusion therapy.

310:662-5-1(a) added the words “non-physician practitioner” to include whom an initial assessment could be performed by

310:662-5-1(c) added the words “or non-physician practitioner” to include whom orders to provide skilled services could be received (two times).

310:662-5-2(a) added the words “or non-physician practitioner’s” to include those responsible to prepare a plan of care at the time of initial assessment.

310:662-5-2(b) added the words “or non-physician practitioner” to include from whom orders for skilled care would be signed and returned timely to the agency

310:662-5-3(c) added the words “or non-physician practitioners” to include professionals in which care is provided in accordance with



310:662-5-3(c) (1)(F) added the words “or non-physician practitioner” to whom timely coordination is required.

310:662-5-3(c)(2)(B) added the words “or non-physician practitioner” to professionals whom licensed practical nurses are expected to assist.

310:662-5-3(d) added the words “or non-physician practitioner” to professions whom qualified therapist are expected to assist.
