Facility is designed to be a safe place for families needing emergency assistance from life's hiccups. Other information includes:

- Families with children birth 7 years welcome
- Children with disabilities are welcome
- Timeframe for a child can be up to 24 hours
- Facility has a maximum capacity of 10-15 children at a time
- Facility located near bus line for convenience
- Security and a nurse on staff at all times
- Citizenship not an issue
- A required release for medical treatment must be signed by all parents/custodians in the event of a medical emergency
- Bilingual volunteers needed
