Metropolitan statistical area (MSA), county and other subarea information

Jobless rates move up over the year for most counties in Oklahoma in August

In September, Latimer County posted Oklahoma's highest county unemployment rate of 6.1 percent. McIntosh County had the second-highest rate for the month. Cimarron County had the lowest county unemployment rate of 1.7 percent in September. Unemployment rates in September were higher than a year earlier in 63 counties, lower in seven counties and unchanged in seven counties.


