

Behavior

What is behavior? "The behavior of a tumor is the way it acts within the body. A tumor can grow in place without the potential for spread (/0, benign); it can be malignant but still growing in place (/2, noninvasive or in situ); it can invade surrounding tissues (/3, malignant, primary site)" as defined by International Classification of Diseases for Oncology, Third Edition (ICD-O-3)

Non-Reportable Terms

Please do not report these to the Central Cancer Registry

- > When the diagnosis is not definitive
 - a. e.g Lentigo maligna vs lentigo vs atypical seborrheic keratosis
- Atypical melanocytic proliferation
- Dermatofibroma
- Proliferation of atypical melanocytes
- Junctional melanocytic neoplasm
- Atypical melanocytes
- > Lentiginous junctional melanocytic neoplasm
- Severely atypical dermoepidermal nevomelanocytic proliferation
- Hypertrophic scale containing melanin pigment and rare melanocyte
- Tricholemmal Carcinoma

Non-Reportable Diagnosis List

Malignant histologies (in situ and invasive) (Not required)

Skin primary (C440-C449) with any of the following histologies

- Malignant neoplasm (8000-8005)
- Epithelial carcinoma (8010-8046)
- Papillary and squamous cell carcinoma (8050-8084)
- AIN III (8077) arising in perianal skin (C445)
- Basal cell carcinoma (8090-8110)

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Atypical Junctional Melanocytic Proliferation *is not synonymous with* Lentigo Maligna. <u>To be reportable the final diagnosis</u> would also need to have a reportable diagnosis like Melanoma In Situ or Lentigo Maligna.
