Vici-Camargo Ambulance Service is currently serving Dewey County as a licensed "522 Ambulance District." This EMS serves most of the western half of Dewey County, parts of eastern Ellis County, and part of southwestern Woodward County. Vici-Camargo EMS is a financially stable EMS that is funded by a 3.11 mil ad valorem tax and collected charges for service. 100% of the population of Dewey County has ambulance coverage. The primary coverage area is approximately 534 square miles with a population of approximately 1086. Vici-Camargo EMS is a volunteer agency that maintains 24/7 coverage of our area. This EMS also has 1 full time licensed paid staff member and is governed by a board that is appointed by the Dewey County Commissioners.

Vici-Camargo EMS maintains mutual aid agreements with the surrounding EMS agencies allowing for Advanced Life Support Intercepts. Additionally Vici-Camargo EMS occasionally provides inter-facility transports for BLS patients for 3 neighboring hospitals (Newman Memorial Hospital, Seiling Municipal Hospital and Alliance Health Woodward Hospital).

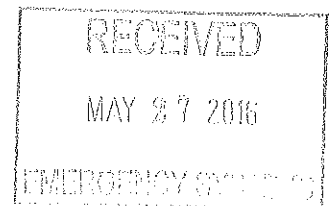

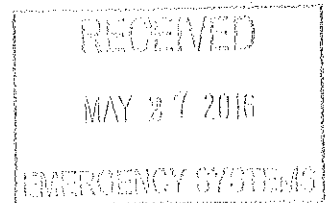

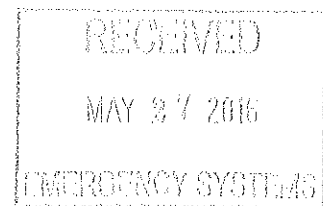

The primary coverage area is approximately 350 square miles with a population of approximately 850. Leedeey EMS is a volunteer agency that maintains 24/7 coverage of our area. This EMS is governed by a board that is appointed by the Dewey County Commissioners.

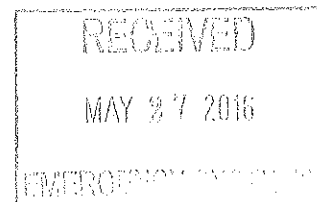

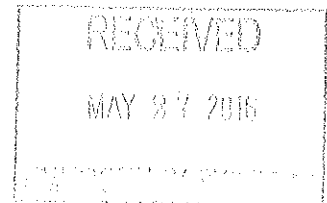

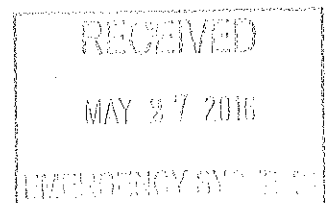

Taloga Ambulance Service is currently serving in Dewey County as a state certified Volunteer Ambulance Service under the management and direction of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Taloga. The Ambulance Service is funded by one-half of one percent (1/2 of 1%) city sales tax, donations, collected charges from runs, and 0.03% of the Dewey County Public Facilities Tax.

The primary coverage area is approximately two hundred seventy five (275) square miles. The Ambulance Service is maintained 24/7 by licensed EMT's. The Board of Trustees appoints the Ambulance Supervisor.

Taloga Ambulance Service maintains mutual aid agreements with the surrounding EMS agencies.

Subject: Community Ambulance Service, Seiling, OK

Community Ambulance Service in Seiling, OK is currently serving Dewey County as a licensed "522 Ambulance District". The EMS serves most of the eastern half of Dewey County, parts of western Major County and southeast Woodward County. Community Ambulance Service is a financially stable EMS that is funded by a 3 Mil advalorem tax and collected charges for services rendered. The primary coverage area is approximately 1100 square miles with an approximate 2250 residents.

Community Ambulance Service is a primary paid volunteer service (EMT's and EMR's) with 2 full time paramedics covering 24/7. The service is governed by the Community Ambulance Service Board of Directors appointed by the Dewey County Board of Commissioners.

Community Ambulance Service has mutual aid agreements with the surrounding EMS agencies and transports primarily to the only hospital located in Dewey County, Seiling Municipal Hospital. However, State Protocols direct patient destination and patients are taken to the most appropriate hospital for their condition.
