Ladies and Gentlemen,

The Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education (ODCTE) administers testing sites have been closed due to the Covid-19 virus and mitigation efforts. This has delayed the cognitive testing for Emergency Medical Responders (EMRs) that have completed their EMR course.

In response to the changing situation, ODCTE has implemented a new process to allow for remote testing. Specifically, they are putting in place a temporary option to allow some testing to occur through online proctoring using ProctorU. The Emergency Medical Responder Exam Cognitive Exam is eligible for remote testing.

System requirements and application process for the exam are detailed in the OCDTE "Health and Professional Certification Test Procedures during COVID-19" manual. That manual is at this link: <u>www.okhcp.com</u>.
