February Invoice Report

Of the 20 FQHCs in Oklahoma, 15 entered into a contract with the OSDH for assistance with uncompensated care costs incurred for providing primary care, dental, or behavioral health services to the uninsured. Of these 15 FQHCs, 7 submitted invoices, and of these 7, only 3 FQHCs were determined to be eligible for UCF assistance.



For services provided in February, the Uncompensated Care Fund reimbursed FQHCs for approximately 1,131 uninsured encounters.

Total UCC = \$317,009.96 Total UCF Available = \$212,706.41

Each qualifying FQHC received approximately 67.09% of their requested reimbursement amount.
