## SFY 2015 FQHC Uncompensated Care Fund (UCF)

June Invoice Report

Of the 19 FQHCs in Oklahoma, 14 entered into a contract with the OSDH for assistance with uncompensated care costs incurred for providing primary care, dental, or behavioral health services to the uninsured. Of these 14 FQHCs, 9 submitted invoices, and of these 9, only 4 FQHCs were determined to be eligible for UCF assistance.



For services provided in June, the Uncompensated Care Fund reimbursed FQHCs for approximately 1,270 uninsured encounters.

Total UCC = \$357,880.12 Total UCF Available = \$212,706.41

Each qualifying FQHC received approximately 59.43% of their requested reimbursement amount.
