4. **Reports– Health Department Programs:**

- Nurse Aide Registry and Certification Vicki Kirtley, Administrative Programs Manager presented the Nurse Aide Registry's quarterly reports. A copy of this report is attached for your information.
- Home Care Agency Administrator Certification Espaniola Bowen, Administrative Programs Manager presented the Home Care Administrator Registry quarterly report. A copy of this report is attached for your information.
- Home Services Division (37min) LaTrina Frazier, Ph.D., Administrative Program Manager presented the Home Care and Hospice licensure and federal deficiencies and surveys conducted. Also discussed future promulgation of Hospice Rules to reflect HB1085 Hospice Administrator CEU requirements.

5. Strategic Planning – LaTrina Frazier

Rayetta Dominguez chair invited all individuals present in the room to participate in the Strategic Planning exercise. Participants numbered off 1 through 5 and were divided based on number into 5 groups.

Ground Rules Established - Show of Hands; No talking at the same time; Cell phones muted; Parking lot (stay on subject); Respect others opinions; Knock Knock Rule

Groups identified 5 Areas of Interest for the Advisory Council to focus on within its jurisdictional authority.

Group 1:

Explore certification of need Home Health & Hospice; License Enforcement for Private Duty; Department of Health with tabs on website directly for Home Health, Hospice, Palliative Care; Regulation transition from expired regulation to new regulations; Need Assessment Study

Group 2:

Clear definition of Palliative Care; How will state govern palliative care; Role of licensed private care in patient care; Detail the scope of practice of CNA/CHHA/PCA

Group 3:

Identify distinction/separation of palliative care and look at other palliative care acts; recommendations as home based palliative care expands; clarification for how to get current regulation changes or new regulations enacted (level playing field for HHA/CAN/PCA/CMA); Home Care assessments for non-medical agencies do not require RN; Clarification of Hospice rules/regulations in the Nursing Home setting – who contact/mediate

Group 4:

Define/Clarify Palliative Care for council/public (Define Services); Identify Palliative Care services currently existent in Oklahoma; HH/HC/Hospice agencies providing "Pro bono" services – how does that implicate licensure & payment HH/HC criteria met = Donut Pro bono = Hospice; Population Health – use resources existing/new; Role of non-licensed caregiver

Group 5:

Renewed focus on patient safety and Survey Process; Establish best practices of palliative care for Home Health agencies – definition of palliative care in the Home Care Act; Public Service Announcement related to

Palliative/Hospice/ Home Health; Explore clarity regarding Medical Director relationships in home health and hospice; Department of Health: Introduce staff and communicate any/all policy changes

Each participant was instructed they had 5 voting points but could place no more than 2 points on any given topic. This was open to all members.
