Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Chair Kari Beggs at 9:32 a.m.

II. Roll Call

III. Introductions and Announcements

OSDH staff introduced themselves and included Brandon Bowen, Daniel Whipple, Heather Booher, and Cinstralia Edwards. Mr. Bowen introduced Cinstralia Edwards as administrative assistant for the Trauma Division. She will be handling RTAB and CQI functions among others.

- IV. Approval of Minutes November 12th, 2015
 - James Wilkins made a motion to approve the minutes as is, and it was seconded by Chelsea Bishop. A roll call vote was taken with unanimous approval.
- V. Business (Discussion and appropriate action)
 - A. Regional Stroke Plan draft Vote to forward to RTAB for review Kari Beggs reviewed the education meetings held for healthcare coalition members within Region 5. Numerous small changes were made to the Stroke Plan to accommodate concerns from stakeholders. It was also mention that Holdenville General Hospital was having difficulty obtaining transfer agreements. A concern was also raised regarding stroke patient priorities as outlined in the plan and those priorities being approved by the Oklahoma Trauma and Emergency Response Advisory Council (OTERAC). Kari Beggs stated that the pre-hospital and hospital algorithms as well as education and other resources will be added

to the final draft of the stroke plan for the next Region 5 RTAB. James Wilkins discussed beginning the Consolidated Regional Plan by rewriting the Regional plan forward and incorporate appendices for time-sensitive medical emergencies such as trauma, stroke, etc.

A motion was made by Robyn Baldridge to forward the Stroke Plan to the RTAB for review. The motion was seconded by Diana Walters and was passed after a unanimous roll call vote.

B. Regional Strategic Plan

There was discussion regarding whether the RTAB should be a "business" meeting or if it should offer additional incentives to attend and garner communication, especially regarding training and education opportunities.

There was also discussion of how to obtain "buy-in," remove barriers, and increase participation from Board Members for Regional matters. A survey was discussed to obtain a list of concerns for Regional partners so that they can be discussed at our upcoming meetings.
