MINUTES

- I. Call to Order The meeting was called to order at 1:01 pm by Chair Kathy O'Dell
- II. Roll Call Roll Call by verbal response with quorum met. See attached roster
- III. Introductions and Announcements None
- **IV. Approval of Minutes** July 18th, 2017: A motion was made by Ryan Lawson and Seconded by Bruce Kelley. A roll call vote was taken, and the motion passed.

V. Reports

- A. Emergency Systems Report David Graham
 - 1. Emergency Systems has one new employee he is Ethan Barstow. Mr. Barstow is an EMS Administrator with regulatory. You will probably see him around when we perform inspections.
 - 2. Dr. Stewart has scheduled a Trauma Registry training in Lawton at Comanche County Memorial Hospital on October 17th, 2017 from 10:00 am 4:00 pm. If you have someone that needs this training have them contact Dr. Stewart.
 - 3. OKEMSIS the version two website is closed but you can still access version two through Report Writer at this time if you need reports from version two. If you have issues contact Mr. Martin Lansdale.
 - 4. The Oklahoma Trauma Emergency Response Advisory Council (OTERAC) meet on September 6th, 2017. Some of the topics covered were.
 - a. The Good Samaritan rule update working group is continuing to meet and work through the process to allow a non-medical person possibly exposed to a communicable disease to receive treatment if they rendered care.
 - b. Radiography exchange The major hospitals in Tulsa and Oklahoma City have meet with each other and their respective IT departments. From these meetings this seems to be a doable project that they will work on and test.
 - c. Triage Tags working group is looking at a common triage tag for the state so it is not as confusing when a major incident happens and the hospitals receive patients that have several different triage tags.
 - d. National Trauma Care System this is looking at integrating military and civilian trauma systems to achieve zero preventable deaths after trauma. Oklahoma has a few hospitals that have military personnel working with them in the Emergency Rooms and Surgery to help them maintain their skills.
 - e. Dr. Cathey and Dr. Stewart will be presenting a ten year trauma review in a few minutes.

- A. 2018 Board Rotation Discussion Vote to approve: No discussion motion to approve the Board Rotation for 2018 made by Melissa Kelly and Seconded by James Annas. Roll call vote motion passed
- B. 2018 Regional Planning Committee and Continuous Quality Improvement Committee members – Discussion – Vote to approve: David Graham brought to the boards attention that the bylaws for regions 2, 4 and 7 all state to try and keep the CQI committee to no more than ten members. The committee has 13 members at this time. Region 7 would like to add three members Region 2 is looking to add one member and Region 4 is looking to add one member. This would bring the committee to 18 members and require the committee have at 10 members to meet quorum. The Board was advised this is their committee and it is up to them to decide if they would like to add the three new members. Bruce Kelley stated that the committee has not had an issue of not being able to meet quorum in the past and does not think that adding these new members will cause an issue. Bruce Kelley made the motion to approve the members listed for the Regional Planning Committee and Continuous Quality Improvement Committee, Seconded by Melissa Kelly. Roll call vote motion passed.

VII. Presentation

A. Trauma System Ten Year Review - Dr. Cathey and Dr. Stewart presented data obtained from the trauma registry for the last 10 years. The data showed that most level III trauma centers in the northeast part of the state are treating fewer trauma patients than they did 10 years ago. The data also showed that most of the trauma being transferred is of the low acuity trauma patients. The most common pediatric transfer from level III facilities was a humorous fracture. Summary is that the data shows that a lot of trauma patients that could be treated in a level III facility keeping
