

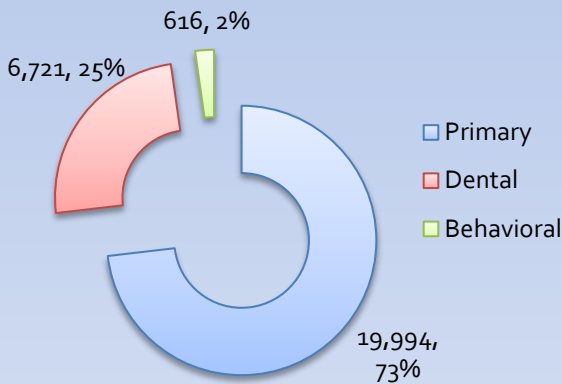
SFY 2015 FQHC Uncompensated Care Fund (UCF)

Fourth Quarter Invoice Report

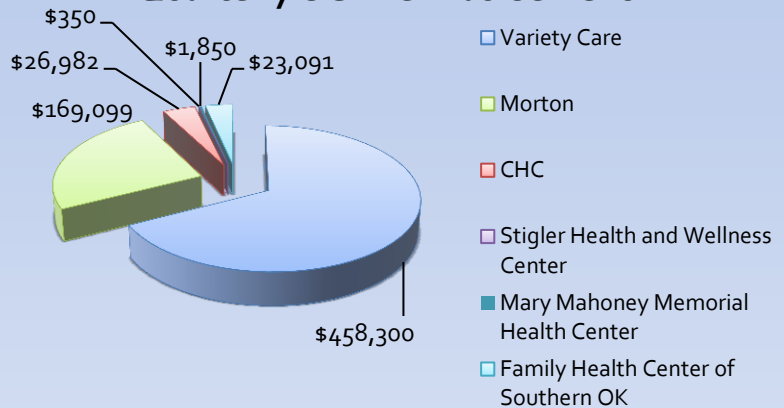
Of the 19 FQHCs in Oklahoma, 14 entered into a contract with the OSDH for assistance with uncompensated care costs incurred for providing primary care, dental, or behavioral health services to the uninsured. Of these 14 FQHCs, 12 submitted invoices, and of these 12, only 4 FQHCs were determined to be eligible for UCF assistance for services delivered April through June of 2015. Two Additional FQHCs received a percentage of surplus funds from SFY 2015.

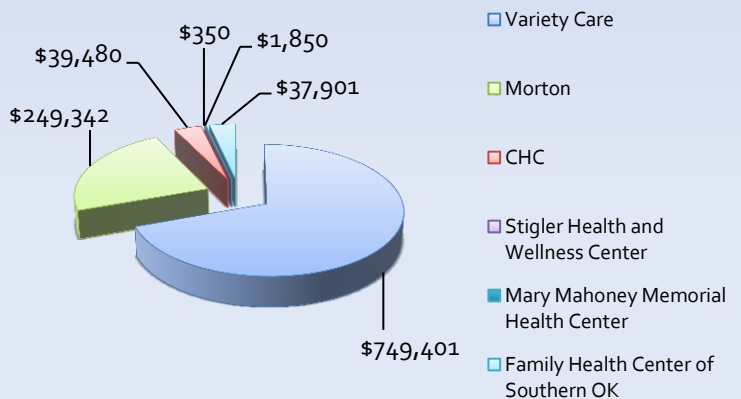
Encounters by Service

In the Fourth Quarter of State Fiscal Year 2015, the Uncompensated Care Fund reimbursed FQHCs for approximately **3,790** uninsured encounters.

Total UCC = \$1,076,126

Total UCF Available = \$679,675

The Uncompensated Care Fund reimbursed 63.15% of all Uncompensated Care Costs claimed by eligible FQHCs.
