First Quarter Invoice Report

Of the 19 FQHCs in Oklahoma, 15 entered into a contract with the OSDH for assistance with uncompensated care costs incurred for providing primary care, dental, or behavioral health services to the uninsured. Of these 15 FQHCs, 12 submitted invoices, and of these 12, only 3 FQHCs were determined to be eligible for UCF assistance for services delivered July through September of 2015.



Encounters by Service




In the First Quarter of State Fiscal Year 2016, the Uncompensated Care Fund reimbursed FQHCs for approximately 3,653 uninsured encounters.


Total UCC = \$1,175,281.08 Total UCF Available = \$638,119.23
