Fourth Quarter Invoice Report

Of the 20 FQHCs in Oklahoma, 12 entered into a contract with the OSDH for assistance with uncompensated care costs incurred for providing primary care, dental, or behavioral health services to the uninsured. Of these 12 FQHCs, 8 submitted invoices, and of these 8, only 2 FQHCs were determined to be eligible for UCF assistance for services delivered April through June of 2017.

Note: * Number of patients/encounters only includes months in which the FQHC was eligible for reimbursement.



Encounters by Service




Total UCC = \$683,375.31 Total UCF Available = \$578,646.48
