First Quarter Invoice Report

Of the 20 FQHCs in Oklahoma, 7 entered into a contract with the OSDH for assistance with uncompensated care costs incurred for providing primary care, dental, or behavioral health services to the uninsured. Of these 7 FQHCs, 6 submitted invoices, and of these 6, 5 FQHCs were determined to be eligible for UCF assistance for services delivered July through September of 2017.

Note: * Number of patients/encounters only includes months in which the FQHC was eligible for reimbursement.



In the First Quarter of State Fiscal Year 2018, the Uncompensated Care Fund reimbursed FQHCs for approximately 2,622 uninsured encounters.

Total UCC = \$990,251.79 Total UCF Available = \$484,982.75

The Uncompensated Care Fund reimbursed 48.98% of all Uncompensated Care Costs claimed by eligible FQHCs.
