Alternative Fuels Program and Legislative Updates

Jim Williams, Director, Safety Standards Division, reported on program updates. Jim stated station inspections happened in Stillwater, Enid, Billings and Pauls Valley in the NE Sector as well as Guthrie, Oklahoma City, Watonga, and Kingfisher in the NW Sector. There were also some re-inspections in the past month. There are plans for more re-calibrations and inspections in the months of August and September. It has been reported that RS Fuels has been decommissioned and is being sold. The CNG Pod Assembly Project at the OnCue on 23rd street continues to be a work in progress. They have also been working with the National Institute of Standards (NIST) performing comparisons and gathering data.

ACOG & INCOG Updates

Eric Pollard gave an update of the ACOG public fleet grant program. They gave out 4.2 million dollars for carbon reduction projects to eight entities in central Oklahoma. The annual report to the Department of Energy showed 15 million gallons of gasoline saved this year. A battery recycling facility called the Green Lion in Atoka is gearing up for recycling of batteries from electric vehicles to get 2nd and 3rd lives out of them. They are a part of 8 different grant opportunities and are willing to do some training or subsidize training if needed. You can contact them if you are aware of training needed.
