

**Minutes of the
Oklahoma Corporation Commission
State of Oklahoma**

February 22, 2022 – 9:30 a.m.

These are the minutes for the Corporation Commission's ("Commission") regular meeting conducted February 22, 2022, in accordance with the Open Meeting Act. The audio was recorded in Room 301 of the Commission's principal offices at 2101 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Archived Commission meeting recordings may be accessed on the Commission's website.

The notice and agenda for the meeting were publicly posted at the Oklahoma City offices of the Commission at 10:30 a.m. February 17, 2022, by Commission employees acting under the direction of the Judicial and Legal Services Division. The notice and agenda are also made available to the public on the Commission's website. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes as Appendix A.

Chairman Murphy called the meeting to order at 9:32 a.m.

Call to Order, Announcement Concerning Public Notice and Determination of Quorum

Members present in Room 301 were Chairman Dana Murphy, Vice Chairman Bob Anthony and Commissioner Todd Hiatt. A quorum of the Commission was present. Interested parties participated in person or by teleconference/videoconference. Commissioner Murphy provided information regarding possible inclement weather for the next couple of days and possible continuances.

Consideration of Proposed or Potential Orders in Causes on Daily Signing Agenda Docket

The daily signing agenda of proposed orders in judicial cases was presented by Peggy Mitchell, commission secretary. Discussion was held. The Commissioners unanimously approved the proposed orders (through a **roll call vote**) with the exception of CD 201902401, CD 202102670, CD 202102772 and EN 201800410, which were stricken; and Commissioner Murphy did not participate in EN 202100237.

Consideration of Proposed or Potential Orders in Causes on 24-hour Signing Agenda Docket

The 24-hour signing agenda of proposed orders was presented by Ms. Mitchell. Discussion was held. The Commissioners unanimously approved (through a **roll call vote**) the proposed orders.

Hearing and Possible Vote(s) to Determine the Statewide Proration Formula in Cause CD No. 202102956, Applicant: Robyn Strickland, Director of Oil and Gas Conservation Division, Oklahoma Corporation Commission. Relief Sought: Statewide Proration Formula for Unallocated Gas Wells for the Period of April, 2022, through March, 2023

Commissioner Murphy announced the agenda item and recognized Susan Conrad, attorney, who introduced the cause and provided procedural history. Duncan Woodliff, senior oil and gas specialist, provided testimony and answered the Commissioners' questions. No public comment was received. Discussion was held.


Ms. Conrad provided suggested wording for a motion: move that the Commission vote to approve the statewide proration formula for unallocated gas wells to remain at the current rate of the greater of 75% of the wellhead calculated absolute open flow potential or 3,000 MCF/Day for the period of April 1, 2022, through March 31, 2023. Chairman Murphy **MADE A MOTION**, suggested by Ms. Conrad, as stated above.
