

**Minutes of the  
Oklahoma Corporation Commission

**November 2, 2023 – 1:30 p.m.**

These are the minutes for the Corporation Commission’s (“Commission”) regular meeting conducted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act on November 2, 2023, in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50, Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. The notice and agenda for the meeting were publicly posted at the principal office of the Commission at the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 at 1:00 p.m., October 31, 2023, by Commission employees acting under the direction of Chairman Todd Hiatt. 

**The motion passed.**


