September 24, 2024 – 1:30 p.m.

These are the minutes for the Corporation Commission’s (“Commission”) regular meeting conducted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act on September 24, 2024, in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50, Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Archived Commission meeting recordings may be accessed on the Commission’s website.

The notice and agenda for the meeting were publicly posted at the principal office of the Commission at the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 at 1:15 p.m., September 20, 2024, by Commission employees acting under the direction of Chairman Kim David. Chairman David called the meeting to order at 1:31 p.m.

Members present were Chairman Kim David, Vice Chairman Bob Anthony, and Commissioner J. Todd Hiatt. A quorum of the Commission was present. Interested persons participated in the meeting in person or by teleconference/videoconference when and as authorized.

Discussion and possible vote(s) regarding direction to Commission staff on VIII (A)-(C) No votes were taken and no directions were given to staff.


