These are the minutes for the Corporation Commission's ("Commission") regular meeting conducted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act on March 19, 2025, in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50, Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. The notice and amended agenda for the meeting were publicly posted at the principal office of the Commission at the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 at 11:30 a.m., March 18, 2025, by Commission employees acting under the direction of Chairman Kim David. The notice and amended agenda are also made available to the public on the Commission's website, Oklahoma.gov/occ. A copy of the notice and amended agenda is attached to these minutes as Appendix A.

Chairman David called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

Members present were Chairman Kim David and Commissioner Brian Bingman. Commissioner Todd Hiatt was not present. A quorum of the Commission was present. Interested persons participated in the meeting in person or by teleconference/videoconference when and as authorized.

Approval of minutes of prior meeting(s) Commissioner David announced the agenda item and recognized Garey Wortham, commission secretary, to present the minutes for approval. The Commissioners unanimously approved the minutes for February 11, 2025, at 1:30 p.m., March 6, 2025, at 9:30 a.m., March 6, 2025, at 1:30 p.m., and March 12, 2025, at 1:30 p.m.

No votes were taken and no directions were given to staff.


