These are the minutes for the Corporation Commission’s (“Commission”) special meeting conducted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act on March 31, 2025, in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50, Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. The notice and agenda for the meeting were publicly posted at the principal office of the Commission at the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 at 11:00 a.m., March 26, 2025, by Commission employees acting under the direction of Chairman Kim David. Notice was provided in writing to the Oklahoma Secretary of State at least forty-eight hours in advance of the meeting, and the notice and agenda are also made available to the public on the Commission’s website, [oklahoma.gov/occ](http://oklahoma.gov/occ).
