

**Minutes of the  
Oklahoma Corporation Commission  
State of Oklahoma**

**April 7, 2026 – 1:30 p.m.**

These are the minutes for the Corporation Commission’s (“Commission”) special meeting conducted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act on April 7, 2026, in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50, Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Archived Commission meeting recordings may be accessed on the Commission’s website.

The notice and agenda for the meeting were posted prominently and publicly at the principal office of the Commission at the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 at 3:15 p.m., April 2, 2026, and at the District 1 Tulsa Field Office for the Oil and Gas Conservation Division, Oklahoma Corporation Commission, 5100 E. Skelly Dr., Tulsa, Oklahoma 74135 at 3:15 p.m., April 2, 2026, by Commission employees acting under the direction of Chairman Kim David. Notice was provided in writing to the Oklahoma Secretary of State at least forty-eight hours in advance of the meeting, and the notice and agenda are also made available to the public on the Commission’s website, [oklahoma.gov/occ](http://oklahoma.gov/occ). A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes as Appendix A.

Chairman David called the meeting to order at 1:30 p.m.

Members present in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50 of the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building were Commissioner J. Todd Hiatt and Commissioner Brian Bingman. Chairman Kim David participated in the meeting via teleconference from Suite 900 of the District 1 Tulsa Field Office for the Oil and Gas Conservation Division. A quorum of the Commission was present, and all members of the Commission were both visible and audible to all other members for the entirety of the meeting. Interested persons participated in the meeting in person or by teleconference/videoconference when and as authorized.

Mr. Wortham also announced that Commission staff had requested to strike the proposed orders for Case No. CD 2025-003552 and Case No. CD 2025-004077. The Commissioners unanimously approved the remaining proposed orders.

The Commissioners unanimously approved the proposed orders.

**Presentations, updates, and discussion regarding operational and financial impacts of January 2026's Winter Storm Fern on the Southwest Power Pool, Oklahoma's electric cooperatives, and regulated utilities** Commissioner David announced the agenda item and recognized Commissioner Bingman to conduct this agenda item. Commissioner Bingman recognized representatives from Oklahoma Natural Gas, ONEOK Gas Transportation, Summit Utilities, Oklahoma Gas and Electric Company, Public Service Company of Oklahoma, the Oklahoma Association of Electric Cooperatives, and Southwest Power Pool to provide overviews of their operations plans, including what has been learned and improved upon since January 2026's Winter Storm Fern. Discussion was held.
