

**Minutes of the
Oklahoma Corporation Commission
State of Oklahoma**

June 29, 2026 – 8:30 a.m.

These are the minutes for the Corporation Commission's ("Commission") special meeting conducted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act on June 29, 2026, in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50, Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Archived Commission meeting recordings may be accessed on the Commission's website.

The notice and agenda for the meeting were posted prominently and publicly at the principal office of the Commission at the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 at 2:30 p.m., June 24, 2026, by Commission employees acting under the direction of Chairman Kim David. Notice was provided in writing to the Oklahoma Secretary of State at least forty-eight hours in advance of the meeting, and the notice and agenda are also made available to the public on the Commission's website, oklahoma.gov/occ. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes as Appendix A.

Commissioner David called the meeting to order at 8:32 a.m.

Members present were Chairman Kim David, Commissioner J. Todd Hiatt, and Commissioner Brian Bingman. A quorum of the Commission was present. Interested persons participated in the meeting in person or by teleconference/videoconference when and as authorized.

Hearing on the merits, including consideration of any possible settlement agreements, before an ALJ in Case No. PUD2025-000075, Application of Public Service Company of Oklahoma, an Oklahoma Corporation, for an Adjustment in its Rates and Charges and the Electric Service Rules, Regulations and Conditions of Service for Electric Service in the State of Oklahoma and to Approve Various Cost Recovery Mechanisms and Tariffs Commissioner David announced the agenda item and turned the meeting over to administrative law judge ("ALJ") Ken Behrens to conduct proceedings in this case. ALJ Behrens opened the record in this case, took appearances from the parties, and addressed all prehearing matters. At 8:43 a.m., ALJ Behrens announced that the meeting is in recess until 8:30 a.m. on June 30, 2026, and would be reconvened in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50 of the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building.

At 8:31 a.m. on June 30, 2026, ALJ Behrens reconvened the meeting with all three Commissioners present in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50 of the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building. ALJ Behrens reopened the record, took appearances from the parties, and asked for a status update. The parties proposed to bifurcate the hearing to separately address the revenue requirement issues and the large load tariff issue.

At 8:50 a.m., ALJ Behrens announced that the meeting is in recess until 9:05 a.m. on this date.

At 9:05 a.m., ALJ Behrens reconvened the meeting with all three Commissioners present in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50. ALJ Behrens continued the discussion with counsel for the parties.

At 9:08 a.m., ALJ Behrens announced that the meeting is in recess until 9:17 a.m. on this date.

At 9:17 a.m., ALJ Behrens reconvened the meeting with all three Commissioners present in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50. ALJ Behrens continued the discussion with counsel for the parties. After considering the statements from counsel, ALJ Behrens agreed with the proposal to bifurcate the issues, and determined that revenue requirement related testimony would begin on July 1, 2026, and testimony related to the large load tariff would begin on July 7, 2026.

At 9:22 a.m., ALJ Behrens announced that the meeting is in recess until 8:30 a.m. on July 1, 2026, in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50 of the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building.

At 8:32 a.m. on July 1, 2026, ALJ Behrens reconvened the meeting with all three Commissioners present in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50. ALJ Behrens began to take witness testimony on the revenue requirement issues.

At 10:03 a.m., ALJ Behrens announced that the meeting is in recess until 10:15 a.m. on this date.

At 10:16 a.m., ALJ Behrens reconvened the meeting with Commissioner David and Commissioner Hiett present in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50. Commissioner Bingman was not present. ALJ Behrens continued to take witness testimony.

At 10:18 a.m., Commissioner Bingman rejoined the ongoing meeting in Suite C50.

At 11:18 a.m., ALJ Behrens announced that the meeting is in recess until 11:25 a.m. on this date.

At 11:25 a.m., ALJ Behrens reconvened the meeting with all three Commissioners present in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50. ALJ Behrens continued to take witness testimony.

At 11:51 a.m., ALJ Behrens announced that the meeting is in recess until 1:45 p.m. on this date.

At 1:45 p.m., ALJ Behrens reconvened the meeting with all three Commissioners present in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50. ALJ Behrens continued to take witness testimony.

At 3:17 p.m., ALJ Behrens announced that the meeting is in recess until 3:27 p.m. on this date.

At 3:28 p.m., ALJ Behrens reconvened the meeting with all three Commissioners present in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50. ALJ Behrens continued to take witness testimony.

At 4:29 p.m., ALJ Behrens announced that the meeting is in recess until 9:30 a.m. on July 2, 2026, in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50 of the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building.

At 9:30 a.m. on July 2, 2026, ALJ Behrens reconvened the meeting with all three Commissioners present in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50. ALJ Behrens continued to take witness testimony.

At 10:37 a.m., ALJ Behrens announced that the meeting is in recess until 10:47 a.m. on this date.

At 10:50 a.m., ALJ Behrens reconvened the meeting with all three Commissioners present in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50. ALJ Behrens continued to take witness testimony.

At 12:15 p.m. Commissioner David exited the meeting. Commissioner Hiatt and Commissioner Bingman remained in attendance. At 12:17 p.m., ALJ Behrens announced that the meeting is in recess until 1:30 p.m. on this date.

At 1:30 p.m., ALJ Behrens reconvened the meeting with Commissioner Hiatt and Commissioner Bingman present in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50. Commissioner David was not present. ALJ Behrens continued to take witness testimony.

At 2:24 p.m., ALJ Behrens announced that the meeting is in recess until 9:00 a.m. on July 7, 2026, in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50 of the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building.

At 9:00 a.m. on July 7, 2026, ALJ Behrens reconvened the meeting with all three Commissioners present in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50. ALJ Behrens and the parties discussed a request to continue the proceeding. After considering the statements from counsel, ALJ Behrens determined that a continuance was unnecessary, and that witness testimony related to the large load tariff issue should begin at 1:00 p.m.

At 9:09 a.m., ALJ Behrens announced that the meeting is in recess until 1:00 p.m. on this date.

At 1:00 p.m., ALJ Behrens reconvened the meeting with all three Commissioners present in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50. ALJ Behrens began to take witness testimony on the large load tariff issue.

At 1:21 p.m., ALJ Behrens announced that the meeting is in recess until 1:25 p.m.

At 1:25 p.m., ALJ Behrens reconvened the meeting with Commissioner Hiatt present in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50. Commissioner David and Commissioner Bingman were not present.

At 1:26 p.m., Commissioners David and Commissioner Bingman left the meeting due to the potential need to continue witness examination in camera to discuss confidential information—and comply with the Open Meetings Act. Commissioner Hiatt remained. A quorum of the Commission was not present. ALJ Behrens determined that there was a need to go in camera, and announced that the public virtual access link to the meeting would close during the in camera proceeding, which would be conducted on the private C50 Zoom link, but that any persons who had signed a confidentiality agreement would be permitted to rejoin this Zoom link or remain in Suite C50. ALJ Behrens announced that the public meeting would reconvene at 1:50 p.m. in Suite C50 and in the *Commission Courtroom* Zoom link.

At 1:31 p.m., ALJ Behrens reconvened the confidential in camera review in Suite C50 and in the C50 Zoom link with Commissioner Hiatt present. Commissioner David and Commissioner Bingman were not present. ALJ Behrens took confidential testimony from the witness.

At 1:50 p.m., ALJ Behrens announced that the confidential meeting is in recess, and resumed the public meeting.

At 1:51 p.m., ALJ Behrens reconvened the public meeting in Suite C50 and in the *Commission Courtroom* Zoom link with all three Commissioners present in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50. ALJ Behrens continued to take witness testimony.

At 2:30 p.m., ALJ Behrens announced that the meeting is in recess until 2:40 p.m. on this date.

At 2:40 p.m., ALJ Behrens reconvened the meeting with all three Commissioners present in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50. ALJ Behrens continued to take witness testimony.
