

**Minutes of the
Oklahoma Corporation Commission
State of Oklahoma**

March 5, 2026 – 9:30 a.m.

These are the minutes for the Corporation Commission’s (“Commission”) special meeting conducted in accordance with the Open Meeting Act on March 5, 2026, in the Concourse Theater, Suite C50, Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105. Archived Commission meeting recordings may be accessed on the Commission’s website.

The notice and agenda for the meeting were posted prominently and publicly at the principal office of the Commission at the Will Rogers Memorial Office Building, 2401 North Lincoln Boulevard, Oklahoma City, Oklahoma 73105 at 9:00 a.m., March 3, 2026, by Commission employees acting under the direction of Chairman Kim David. Notice was provided in writing to the Oklahoma Secretary of State at least forty-eight hours in advance of the meeting, and the notice and agenda are also made available to the public on the Commission’s website, oklahoma.gov/occ. A copy of the notice and agenda is attached to these minutes as Appendix A.

Commissioner David called the meeting to order at 9:32 a.m.

Members present were Chairman Kim David, Commissioner J. Todd Hiatt, and Commissioner Brian Bingman. A quorum of the Commission was present. Interested persons participated in the meeting in person or by teleconference/videoconference when and as authorized.

Recognition of Scott Irwin upon his retirement from the Oklahoma Air National Guard

Commissioner David announced the agenda item and recognized Jim Marshall, interim director of administration, to present this agenda item. Mr. Marshall offered thanks to Chief Master Sergeant Scott Irwin for his thirty-three years of service to the Oklahoma Air National Guard and congratulations on his recent retirement from the Oklahoma Air National Guard. Mr. Marshall presented a certificate of commendation to Mr. Irwin for his years of dedication, sacrifice, leadership, and exemplary military service to the State of Oklahoma and the United States of America.

Recognition of Lieutenant Steve Peltó and Officer Brian Wofford with the OCC’s Transportation Division, for professionalism, dedication, and service in support of the recent inter-agency operation

Jim Marshall, interim director of administration, extended appreciation to Lieutenant Steve Peltó and Officer Brian Wofford for their participation in an inter-agency coordination with the U.S. Marshal Service which resulted in apprehension of a fugitive who was traveling through the State of Oklahoma. Mr. Marshall presented certificates of commendation to both Lieutenant Peltó and Officer Wofford for their integrity, bravery, professional conduct, and continued exemplary service to the State of Oklahoma.

The Commissioners unanimously approved the proposed orders.

Discussion and possible vote(s) to approve a final version of the Nuclear Energy Generation Feasibility Study, as required by 17 O.S. § 803, and possible additional direction to Commission staff Commissioner David announced the agenda item and recognized Mark Argenbright, director of the Public Utility Division, to offer a procedural history and status update on this item. Discussion was held. The Commission requested that, in addition to delivering electronically, the Public Utility Division staff prepare three paper copies of the final version of the *Nuclear Energy Generation Feasibility Study*, with one copy to be delivered to the Office of the Governor, one to the Office of the Speaker of the Oklahoma House of Representatives, and one to Office of the President Pro Tempore of the Oklahoma Senate. Commissioner Bingman **MADE A MOTION** *that the Commission approve the Nuclear Energy Generation Feasibility Study and authorize its delivery pursuant to 17 O.S. § 803(D) by the Public Utility Division.* Commissioner David **CALLED FOR A VOTE** on the motion.


