

News from the Oklahoma Corporation Commission



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ADVISORY

The Oklahoma Corporation Commission will deliberate and may vote on the Oklahoma Gas and Electric (OG&E) “scrubber” issue at 1:30 p.m. on Thur. April 28.

- OG&E is requesting that Commissioners approve its plan to install dry scrubbers on both coal-fired generating units at the Sooner Power Plant in order to meet the Environmental Protection Agency’s regional haze plan requirements as allowed by state law.
- The application does not request recovery of the estimated \$500 million cost of the plan.
- If the project is authorized, OG&E will eventually file another application requesting cost recovery.
- In its application, OG&E states that because of the contracts and costs involved in the project, it needs a decision by May 2.
