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STATEMENT: Work of Oklahoma Geological Survey regarding triggered seismicity

We are grateful for the all the work the Oklahoma Geological Survey (OGS) has done and will do on this critical issue.

The findings discussed in the [latest OGS statement](#) have already served as key components in the Oklahoma Corporation Commission's evolving approach to the issue of triggered seismicity, including the requirement of a seismicity review for all proposed disposal wells, further scrutiny of those proposed wells even after review, limited permitting for wells in certain areas, and most recently, an expansion of our "traffic light" approach that, among other things, requires hundreds of Arbuckle disposal well operators to take action to mitigate the risk of triggered seismicity.

There will no doubt be more steps to take, and all options available to the Commission are on the table. There is no issue that has a higher priority for this agency, and the continuing work and commitment of OGS is central to this effort.
