Public Information Acknowledgment

This is a state program, but it uses federal grant funds. If you enroll in and/or receive any environmental work from the program, details about your property and the work done, including your property location, will be on our required state Brownfields Department list and the Federal Brownfields database. We may use your site to showcase program successes. The Brownfields Department is also required to report leveraged funds and activities for enrolled and closed sites, which means Department staff will ask for total expenditures related to redevelopment/remodeling/etc., and for information on number of jobs created due to remediation/redevelopment activities. If you cannot share these numbers, Department staff must use available public sources, like news articles, assessor information, and other credible websites to make estimations for leveraged funds.

Release Case Acknowledgment (Petroleum Storage Tank Division (PSTD) Sites Only)

If contamination above certain levels is found on your property related to a commercial fuel retailer, it will need to be addressed. PSTD will make the Responsible Party determination for the potential release case. The PSTD-determined Responsible Party is potentially liable to cover the 1% copay on the PSTD case, capped at \$5,000.00.

Continuing Obligations Acknowledgment

When you complete our program, you will receive a Certificate of No Action Necessary if no cleanup is needed, or a Certificate of Completion if cleanup/corrective action was necessary. No matter which Certificate you get, it will need to be filed at the County Clerk's office in the county where the property is located. This usually costs a few dollars per page and must be done in person. This Certificate releases you of environmental liability for anything we address during our Brownfields process, and it stays with the property in perpetuity.

"Limited" Assessments Acknowledgment

The Corp Comm has environmental jurisdiction over petroleum storage tanks and oil and gas exploration and production. Therefore, the Brownfields Department Phase II Environmental Site Assessments are considered "limited" because it only addresses contaminants related to activities under our jurisdiction.
