SUMMARY OF MOTIONS AND ACTION ITEMS

MOTION: To approve the Consent Agenda. Lane Sisung (LPSC) motioned / Matt Alvarado (IUC) seconded. *The motion passed unanimously*.

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MINUTES

AGENDA ITEM 1 – CALL TO ORDER AND ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

Chair Agata Malek (NMPRC) called the meeting to order at 8:00 AM Central Time and a quorum was established. Chris Hanson (NDPSC) held proxy for Victor Schock (NDPSC)

AGENDA ITEM 2 – CONSENT AGENDA

The consent agenda included the agenda for the current meeting and the meeting minutes from May 15, 2025.

MOTION: To approve the Consent Agenda. Lane Sisung (LPSC) motioned / Matt Alvarado (IUC) seconded. *The motion passed unanimously.*

AGENDA ITEM 3 – ACTION ITEMS

Angela Sartori (SPP Staff) provided an update on two action items and noted that scenario development in regard to FERC Order 1920 would be discussed at the upcoming RSC Education Session. Ms. Sartori also noted that the action item related to the issuance of a TMEPs survey would be closed.

AGENDA ITEM 4 – FERC UPDATE

Justin Hinton (SPP Staff) reviewed the dockets currently pending before FERC.

AGENDA ITEM 5 – TARGETED MARKET EFFICIENCY PROJECTS (TMEPS)

Jill Ponder (SPP Staff), and Clint Savoy (SPP Staff) reviewed the TMEPs policy and shared the results from the CAWG feedback survey. At the request of the group, Staff will bring back information from the lessons learned from the first TMEPs study and reopen the survey to solicit additional responses from the CAWG. A CAWG vote on this policy is expected at the July meeting.

AGENDA ITEM 6 – RR681 – SEAMS PROJECTS COST ALLOCATION

Aaron Shipley (SPP Staff) reviewed the Seam Projects Cost Allocation revision request (RR), which implements a previously RSC approved policy. Mr. Shipley also reviewed the submitted comments





from stakeholders and discussed the working group approval schedule. Jarred Cooley (SPS) provided additional context for SPS's submitted comments.

MOTION: The CAWG recommends RSC approval of the cost allocation provision in RR681-Seams Projects Cost Allocation, as presented, as implementing approved RSC policies for Seams Transmission Projects. John Krajewski (NPRB) motioned / Matt Alvarado (IUC) seconded. *The motion passed with 11 votes in favor and one abstention (LPSC)*.

AGENDA ITEM 7 – LTCR NETTING OF FLOWS UPDATE

Micha Bailey (SPP Staff) provided an update on the Netting of Flows RR. Mr. Bailey stated that the Market Working Group had reviewed RR and it should be posted soon. The CAWG is expected to begin reviewing the RR in July and an RSC vote is expected in November.

Mr. Bailey also provided an informational update on a market inefficiency in the TCR auction related to electrically equivalent settlement locations. Staff is preparing an RR which will prevent exploitation of the market inefficiency. This RR is expected to be expedited through the working group process and be voted on at the July MOPC meeting.

AGENDA ITEM 9 – CPPTF UPDATE

Sunny Raheem (SPP Staff) and Charles Locke (SPP Staff) provided a status report on the CPP RR. It was issued on May 22 with comments due on June 13. Staff reviewed key updates under this RR and provided an example of NRIS direct assignment and base plan funding. Due to the timing of other working group approvals and the comment period deadline, the CAWG will vote on RR684 during a special meeting on June 20, 2025.

AGENDA ITEM 10 - GI NRIS INTRODUCTION

Sunny Raheem (SPP Staff) introduced an initial discussion on GI NRIS directly assigned upgrades and base plan funding across multiple processes. Staff was assessing CAWG interest in pursuing the proposal on aligning cost allocation for GI directly assigned upgrades when the request is designated to load within a deliverability area and it meets existing base plan funding, delivery point, and safe harbor criteria. The group expressed a desire to move forward with consideration of the proposal.

AGENDA ITEM 11 – 2026 ITP/CPP RENEWABLE POLICY REVIEW & RESOURCE PLAN PHASE 1

Annaliese Behr (SPP Staff) provided an overview of the process, state renewable portfolio standards, and the resource plan phase 1 results and identified ongoing and upcoming milestones.





AGENDA ITEM 13 – RESOURCE ADEQUACY UPDATE

- a. SAWG Report Bradley Payne (SPP Staff) reviewed discussion and actions from the most recent Supply Adequacy Working Group meeting.
- b. REAL Team Report Shawnee Claiborn-Pinto (PUCT) provided brief update on the most recent REAL meeting noting that the main topic was demand response policy.

AGENDA ITEM 14 – DEMAND RESPONSE UPDATE

Bradley Payne (SPP Staff) reviewed the framework and the changes made to the framework in response to stakeholder collaboration. The RSC is expected to consider this policy for endorsement in August.

AGENDA ITEM 15 – LRE PEAK DEMAND ASSESSMENT

Charles Hendrix (SPP Staff) reviewed the LRE Peak Demand Assessment policy and recommendations and its relevance to the demand response policy.

AGENDA ITEM 16 – FERC ORDER 1920 UPDATE

John Krajewski (NPRB) identified an RSC/CAWG to-do list with regard to FERC Order 1920. The list includes:

- 1. Ex- ante cost allocation for long-term regional transmission projects (from 20-year study)
- 2. Optional State Agreement Process to agree on cost allocation for specific projects.

Tessie Kentner (SPP Staff) agreed that these are the two primary items for consideration. The group discussed the RSC's authority to direct a new cost allocation at any time, the factors that have changed since highway/byway was implemented, and the implications if the CPP is approved.

Mr. Krajewski also noted that a review of the Highway Byway cost allocation could be warranted at some time in the near future given the changes in the footprint since 2010, development of the market, and the size of recent and upcoming transmission portfolios.
