Agenda Item 1 – CALL TO ORDER & ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

A. March 12, 2026 Meeting Minutes Approval

MOTION: Move to approve the REAL Team meeting minutes from March 12, 20026. Cindy Ireland (APSC) motioned/Keaton Riddle (Evergy) seconded. *The motion passed unanimously.*

Agenda Item 2 – FERC RESOURCE ADEQUACY UPDATE

Justin Hinton (SPP) provided an update of resource adequacy dockets pending FERC.

Agenda Item 3 – RESOURCE ADEQUACY SEASONAL CONSTRUCT

Charles Hendrix (SPP) reviewed the Resource Adequacy (RA) seasonal construct which includes evaluating whether the RA construct should be expanded to include the spring and fall shoulder seasons to better address reliability risk. Keaton Riddle (Evergy) reviewed the Supply Adequacy Working Group’s (SAWG) position noting that SAWG is not opposed to improving the RA construct but believes the immediate priority is to use existing resources more efficiently and discuss outage coordination in parallel with any RA improvements. Despite being listed as a voting item on the agenda, the group elected to not vote and requested more details regarding annual resource availability. An action item was created to define the scope for an outage coordination task force or small group, including reporting structure and deliverables, to facilitate detailed discussions on outages for review by the SAWG, REAL Team, and Market Working Group (MWG).

Agenda Item 4 – COINCIDENT PEAK VS NON-COINCIDENT PEAK

Alex Crawford (SPP) reviewed the distinction between non-coincident peak (NCP) and coincident peak (CP) and explained how current RA requirements are based on each LRE’s individual peak even though PRM is set using systemwide studies. Staff also reviewed the straw poll taken by SAWG which indicated that most members prefer to retain NCP. Stakeholders discussed system changes and the pros and cons on NCP and CP. A policy vote is slated for the September REAL Team meeting.

Charles Hendrix (SPP) reviewed the REAL Team workplan.
