AGENDA ITEM 1 - CALL TO ORDER

President John Tuma (MN PUC) called the meeting to order at 10:43 a.m. CT.

AGENDA ITEM 2 – PRELIMINARY MATTERS

a. Roll Call and Declaration of a Quorum – all members were accounted for, and a quorum was established.

AGENDA ITEM 3 – FERC DOCKET NO. ER24-1221 – PRM DETERMINATION COMPLIANCE FILING UPDATE

Justin Hinton (SPP) presented the proposed response to the FERC's order asking for a non-exhaustive list of factors that SPP Staff, the Regional State Committee (RSC), and the Board will use in determining the recommended Planning Reserve Margin (PRM). Mr. Hinton reviewed the planned changes to the tariff in Attachment AA. Mr. Hinton confirmed that the proposed list reflects a starting point, and the list may be modified or adjusted. There was discussion regarding removing one item from the list, but no motion was made to modify the strategy or the language. A compliance filing is due June 24, 2024.

AGENDA ITEM 4 – RR620 – JOINT TARGETED INTERCONNECTION QUEUE

List Trudeau (MN PUC) initiated the discussion for the Joint Targeted Interconnection Queue (JTIQ) Revision Request 620. Clint Savoy (SPP) presented the JTIQ framework, reviewed the approved RSC policies, and discussed the objectives and benefits of RR620. Mr. Savoy indicated that stakeholder comments were reviewed within the working groups, which resulted in additional revisions. He also noted that no additional substantive changes are expected, only clean-up and formatting to prepare for a FERC filing. The voting history was also reviewed, and it was stated that RR620 received 88% approval at the recent MOPC meeting.

MOTION: CAWG recommends the RSC approve RR620 as reviewed and implementing approved Regional State Committee JTIQ cost allocation policies (Chuck Hutchinson (NPRB) / Todd Hiett (OCC) seconded). *Passed unanimously*.

AGENDA ITEM 5 – EDUCATION: RESOURCE ADEQUACY

Casey Cathey (SPP) reviewed the key considerations for the Resource Adequacy PRM. Mr. Cathey also presented an assessment of Summer PRM vs. Operating Capacity Margin and Winter PRM vs Operating Capacity Margin. He also reviewed the impact 33% PRM would have on outages and discussed differences between the Base PRM and ACAP PRM. Mr. Cathey stated that the REAL Team asked the Supply Adequacy Working Group to develop a future PRM projection to give a longer-term signal.
