The Military Aviation and Installation Assurance Siting Clearinghouse (Clearinghouse) has reviewed the Wagon Wheel wind farm project in Marshall, Oklahoma. The Clearinghouse found no adverse impacts to DoD missions in the area and has entered a determination of "No Objection with Provision" via the Federal Aviation Administration's Obstruction Evaluation / Airport Airspace Analysis system.

Our response to the FAA included a notification that further expansion beyond the current project area may be problematic due to proximity to military training routes or military training areas.
