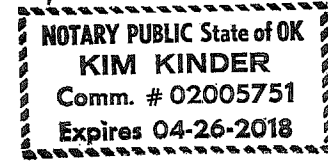

## NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONSTRUCT


In order to comply with the requirements of Oklahoma law, codified as The Oklahoma Wind Energy Development Act, specifically Section 150.21 of Oklahoma Statutes Title 17, and as it relates to certain Rules promulgated by the Oklahoma Corporation Commission ("Commission"), NextEra Energy Resources, LLC (the "Company") hereby informs the Commission of its intent to construct the Crowder wind energy project (the "Project") concurrently located in Caddo and Washita Counties, Oklahoma. It is important to note that this filing is the initiation of the notice of intent to construct and it supersedes the January 30, 2017 filing which was retracted February 1, 2017.

The Project has been under active development since 2016. The most recent FAA form 7460-1 filing was made on January 31, 2017. A summary of the FAA form 7460-1 filings for each wind turbine tower location within the Project boundary is attached as Exhibit A. Exhibit B to this letter presents a diagram showing the real estate analyzed and included in statutory setback compliance. As of the date of this notice, and based on publicly available data, Company attests that the Project design complies with the setbacks required by the OK Siting Laws.

In accordance with Oklahoma law, the Company also confirms it is submitting a notice of intent to construct to the Caddo County and Washita County Board of the Commissioners in the form attached hereto as Exhibit C. Notice is also being provided to the Town of Corn in accordance with OK Siting Laws regarding project facilities located within an incorporated area of a municipality.
