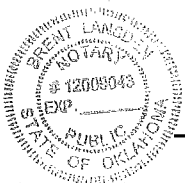

**NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONSTRUCT**

In order to comply with the requirements of Oklahoma law, codified as The Oklahoma Wind Energy Development Act, specifically Section 160.21 of Oklahoma Statutes Title 17, and as it relates to certain Rules promulgated by the Oklahoma Corporation Commission ("Commission"), NextEra Energy Resources, LLC (the "Company") hereby informs the Commission of its intent to construct the Ponderosa wind energy project (the "Project") located in Beaver County, Oklahoma.

The Project has been under active development for several years. The most recent FAA form 7460-1 filing was made on January 27, 2017. A summary of the FAA form 7460-1 filings for each wind turbine tower location within the Project boundary is attached as Exhibit A. Exhibit B to this letter presents a diagram showing the real estate analyzed and included in statutory setback compliance. As of the date of this notice, and based on publicly available data, Company attests that the Project design complies with the setbacks required by the OK Siting Laws.

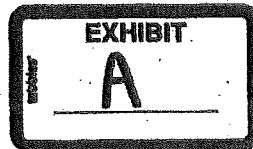
