

In order to comply with the requirements of Section 2 of Oklahoma Senate Bill 808 ("OK Siting Laws"), which was approved by the legislature and signed by the Governor, and in advance of certain rules that are to be promulgated by the Oklahoma Corporation Commission ("Commission") pursuant to the passage of SB 808, North Rim Wind Energy, LLC, hereby informs the Commission of its intent to construct the North Rim Wind energy project (the "Project") located in Beckham County, Oklahoma.

The Project has been under active development for several years. The most recent FAA form 7460-1 filing was made on May 11, 2017. A summary of the May 11, 2017 FAA form 7460-1 filings for each wind turbine tower location within the Project boundary is attached as Exhibit A. Exhibit B to this letter presents a diagram showing the real estate analyzed and included in statutory setback compliance. As of the date of this notice, and based on publicly available data, North Rim Wind Energy, LLC, attests that the Project design complies with the setbacks required by the OK Siting Laws.

In accordance with the OK Siting Laws, North Rim Wind Energy, LLC, also confirms it is submitting a notice of intent to construct to the Oklahoma Corporation Commission in the form attached hereto as Exhibit C. No project facilities are located within an incorporated area of a municipality, and thus no additional notice is required under SB 808.

High speed chase nets three felony charges for California man

While on stationary patrol in the center median near the 8 mile marker on I-40, a Beckham County deputy observed a speeding four door Lexus that would result in an erratic high speed chase landing 41-year-old Lu Yuandong of Davis, California, in the Beckham County Detention Center.
At approximately 6:47 pm on February 10, the deputy observed the California luxury car passing two vehicles at 85 mph in a 70 mph zone.
The officer caught up to the Yuandong at the 10 mile marker, activating his emergency lights and sirens.
After realizing the drive

Yuandong was charged with felony reckless driving, eluding a police officer and resisting a police officer.
He is currently being held in Beckham County Detention Center on a \$5000 bond.
He is due in court on February 26.

Nicholas Ray Billingsley pulled his vehicle into a private drive.

Retinour was arrested at that time with drug trafficking and harboring a fugitive. 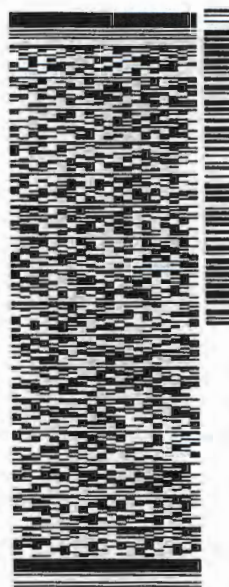

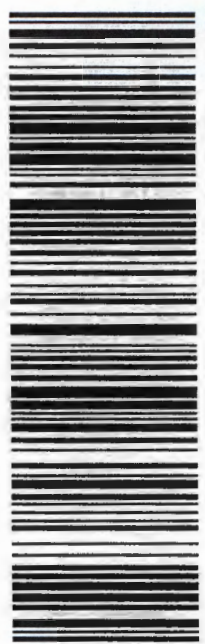
