NOTICE OF INTENT TO BUILD A WIND ENERGY FACILITY

In order to comply with the requirements of the Oklahoma Wind Energy Development Act, 17 OSA § 160.11 et seq. (the "Act"), Seven Cowboy Wind Project, LLC, hereby informs the Oklahoma Corporation Commission (the "OCC") of its intent to construct the Seven Cowboy Wind Project in Kiowa and Washita Counties, Oklahoma (the "Project"). This letter is intended to replace the Notice of Intent letter filed for the Project with the OCC dated February 29, 2016. The Project is submitting this second Notice of Intent to ensure compliance with the Act and due to a re-file of the initial FAA 7460-1 Notice of Proposed Construction forms ("7460-1 Forms") for all turbines in the Project.

Initial 7460-1 Forms for all individual wind turbines or any other individual structure that requires a FAA 7460-1 Form that is a part of the Project is included in Exhibit A. Exhibit B to the letter presents a diagram indicating the Project boundary.

As of this notice, and based on the best publicly available data, Company attests, that the Project design is in full compliance with the setbacks required by the Act and specifically 17 OSA 160.20(A).

In accordance with the notification requirements of the Act, notice of intent to construct will also be subsequently provided to the Kiowa and Washita County Commissioners. Evidence of that forthcoming notice is provided as Exhibit C. No project facilities are located within an incorporated area of a municipality and thus no additional notice is required under the Act. Please do not hesitate to contact us with any questions regarding this filing.
