

NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONSTRUCT

In order to comply with the requirements of Section 3 of Oklahoma Statutes Title 80A, address as Section 160 21 of Oklahoma Statutes Title 17 (collectively referred herein as "OK Saving Laws") which was approved by the legislature and signed by the Governor and a majority of certain judges that are to be promulgated by the Oklahoma Corporation Commission ("Commission") pursuant to the authority of Oklahoma Statutes Title 80A, Chapter 17, Section 3, the Oklahoma Energy Resources, LLC ("OER") hereby informs the Commission of its intent to construct the Mexico Express wind energy project (the "Project") commencing located in Caddo County and Canadian County, Oklahoma.

The Project has been under active development for several years. The most recent FAA form 7800-1 filing was made on July 21, 2014. A summary of FAA form 7800-1 filings for each wind turbine tower location within the Project boundary is attached as Exhibit A. Exhibit B is the letter prepared by OER showing the environmental assessment and inclusion of suitable avoidance compliance. As of the date of this notice, no additional notices are required under OK Saving Laws. The Project design complies with the setbacks required by the OK Saving Laws.

In accordance with the OK Saving Laws, the Commission is hereby submitting a notice of intent to construct to the Caddo County and Canadian County Board of Commissioners. 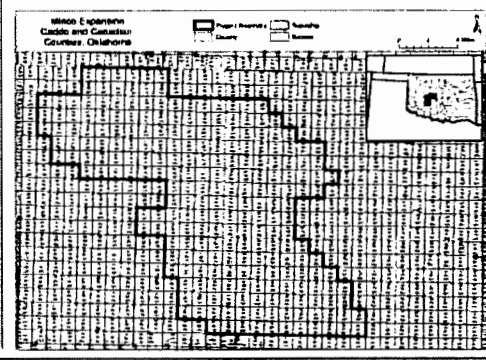

In order to comply with the requirements of Section 2 of Oklahoma Statute Title 806, codified as Section 160.21 of Oklahoma Statutes Title 17, (collectively referred to as "OK Singing Laws"), which was approved by the legislature and signed by the Governor, and in accordance with the requirements of the Oklahoma Corporation Commission ("Commission") pursuant to the passage of OK Singing Laws, NextEra Energy Resources, LLC, the "Company" hereby informs the Commission of its intent to construct the Minco Expansion and energy project (the "Project") concurrently located in Caddo County and Canadian County, Oklahoma.

The Project has been under active development for several years. The most recent FAA form 7460-1 filing was made on January 21, 2016. A summary of the FAA Form 7460-1 filings for each tower and sub-tower location within the Project boundary is attached as Exhibit A. Exhibit B to this letter presents a diagram showing the real estate analyzed and included in statutory setback compliance. As of the date of this notice, and based on publicly available data, Company attests that the Project design complies with the setbacks required by the OK Singing Laws.

In accordance with the OK Singing Laws, the Company also confirms it is submitting a notice of intent to construct to the Caddo County and Canadian County Board of Commissioners in the form attached hereto as Exhibit C. No project facilities are located within an incorporated area of a municipality, and thus no additional notice is required under OK Singing Laws.
