

The following letter and site map were submitted to the Oklahoma Corporation Commission on February 29, 2016 regarding notice of intent to construct the Red Dirt Wind Project in Kingfisher and Logan Counties, Oklahoma. Construction for up to 300 MW of wind turbine generated energy will likely begin in early 2017 and commercial operations are anticipated by the end of 2017. NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONSTRUCT

In order to comply with the requirements of Section 2 of Oklahoma Senate Bill 808 ("SB 808") that was approved by the legislature and signed by the Governor, and in advance of certain rules that are to be promulgated by the Oklahoma Corporation Commission ("Commission") pursuant to the passage of SB 808, Red Dirt Project, LLC, hereby informs the Commission of its intent to construct the Red Dirt Wind Project in Kingfisher and Logan Counties of Oklahoma.

FAA 7460-1 Notice of Proposed Construction or Alteration forms have been filed and a summary of the filing is included in Exhibit A. Exhibit B to the letter presents a diagram indicating the Project boundary. As of this notice, and based on the best publicly available data, Company attests, that the Project design is in full compliance with the setbacks required by SB 808.

In accordance with the notification requirements of SB 808, notice of intent to construct will also be subsequently provided to Garfield and Grant County Commissioners. Evidence of that forthcoming notice provided as Exhibit C. No project facilities are located within an incorporated area of a municipal-

ity and thus no additional notice is required under SB 808.
