NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Applicants, Chesapeake Operating, L.L.C., and Chesapeake Exploration, L.L.C., have filed an amended application in this cause requesting the Corporation Commission to enter an order, as follows: (i) authorizing and permitting an exception to the permitted well location tolerances in the 640-acre irregular horizontal drilling and

spacing unit comprised of the E/2 of Section 26 and the E/2 of Section 35, Township 25 North, Range 11 West of the IM, Alfalfa County, Oklahoma, for the Mississippian common source of supply, so as to allow a well to be drilled as follows:

Location of Wellbore at Completion Interval: The interval will be cemented along the entire length of the lateral. The interval from the first perforation to the last perforation will be no closer than 150 feet from the north line and no closer than 330 feet from the west line of the unit comprising the E/2 of Section 26 and the E/2 of Section 35, and no closer than 150 feet from the south line and no closer than 330 feet from the west line of the unit comprising

the E/2 of Section 26 and the E/2 of Section 35, Township 25 North, Range 11 West of the IM, Alfalfa County, Oklahoma, and to be completed in and produce hydrocarbons from the above-named common source of supply, (ii) providing for the re-opening of the cause at such time as the bottom hole location of the well proposed hereunder has been determined; and (iii) establishing a proper allowable with no downward adjustment made thereto.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the amended application in this cause requests that the order be entered in this matter be made effective as of the date of the execution thereof or as of a date prior thereto and that the authorization and permission requested herein run in favor of one or both of the Applicants, including Chesapeake Operating, L.L.C. acting by and through its agent Chesapeake Operating, L.L.C., or any other party recommended by Applicants.

NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONSTRUCT

In order to comply with the requirements of Oklahoma law, codified as The Oklahoma Wind Energy Development Act, specifically Section 160.21 of the Oklahoma Statutes Title 17, and as it relates to certain Rules promulgated by the Oklahoma Corporation Commission ("Commission"), NextEra Energy Resources, LLC (the "Company") hereby informs the Commission of its intent to construct the Turkey Creek wind energy project (the "Project") concurrently located in Alfalfa, Garfield, and Major Counties, Oklahoma.

The Project has been under active development since the beginning of 2016. The FAA form 7460-1 filing was made on September 23, 2016. A summary of the FAA form 7460-1 filings for each wind turbine tower location within the Project boundary is attached as Exhibit A. Exhibit B to this letter presents a diagram showing the real estate analyzed and the proposed Project description/boundary. As of the date of this notice, and based on publicly available data, Company attests that the Project design complies with the setbacks required by the OK Siting Laws. Also, it is important to note that the Project Description detailed in the attached map is consistent with the clarified map, including complete section, range and township information, is the same as that recently provided to the Oklahoma Corporation Commission.

In accordance with Oklahoma law, the Company also confirms it is submitting a notice of intent to construct to the Alfalfa, Garfield, and Major County Board of the Commissioners in the form attached hereto as Exhibit C. Notice is also being provided to the Towns of Carrier, Golby, Helena, and Hillsdale in accordance with OK Siting Laws regarding project facilities located within an incorporated area of a municipality.
