SBI with Adolescents teaches health professionals to conduct screening, brief intervention, and referral to treatment with adolescents in a variety of settings. This virtual learning experience introduces the foundational concepts and then coaches learners through simulated case scenarios to provide them practice and build confidence. The simulation includes a final challenge scenario to assess learners' competency in conducting a brief intervention.

CONTENTS & LEARNING GOALS

- Prevalence of substance use among adolescents and the critical role of providers in prevention and treatment
- Screening adolescents using validated tools and appropriate interventions for different risk levels
- Coordinating referrals to specialist treatment and follow-up care
- Assessment of users' competency in applying motivational interviewing and the Brief Negotiated Interview framework
